Working language of the conference: **Ukrainian, English, Russian.**

Based on the results of the conference, it is planned to publish a collection of abstracts in electronic form, which will be posted on the website of the State University of Infrastructure and Technologies. Applications for participation in the conference and abstracts are accepted until **December 1, 2020** to the e-mail address: [irusia.tarnovska@gmail.com](mailto:irusia.tarnovska@gmail.com) (application form is attached).

Applications and abstracts are made out in separate files according to the sample: Petrenko\_Zayavka (for the application), Petrenko\_Tezy (for theses) in the format doc. or docx. The volume of abstracts - up to 2 pages.

Requirements for design: MS Word, font Times New Roman, size 14 pt, line spacing - single, paragraph - 1.25 cm; margins: left - 2 cm, right - 2 cm, top - 3 cm, bottom - 2 cm. Place the pictures in the text, text wrapping - top and bottom, alignment - in the center. Under the figure indicate the numbering (Fig. 1.) and name, description (if necessary), aligning the center. When using tables it is necessary to specify numbering (Table 1.) and the name, aligning in the center. Font size in tables - 14 or 12, spacing - 1.

For formulas, use the internal Microsoft Word formula editor.

References in the text should be in square brackets.

The structure of the abstracts of the report:

- Title of abstracts (bold, size: 14, centered).
- Author's name (bold, size: 14, width alignment, no more than 3 authors allowed) and information (degree, academic title (if any), position and organization represented by the author, etc. - regular font, size: 14)
- Main text.
- List of sources used (in alphabetical order or in reference order).
